General Instructions:

- Students must report to school in **neat and clean uniforms**, with **clean socks** (school socks) and **school prescribed shoes**. Floaters, chappals, sandals etc will strictly not be permitted.
- **Nails must be well-trimmed and clean** at all times.
- **Appropriate innerwear** is compulsory:
 - **Boys:** Vests must be worn.
 - **Girls:** Slips and cycling shorts must be worn. For girls wearing skirts, black leggings are allowed only during winter months.
- **Girls in Grade 6 and above:** Waistcoat is a mandatory component of the formal school uniform.

Hair Guidelines:

- **Boys:** Must maintain a **very short haircut / NDA cut** at all times.
- **Girls (Short Hair):** Hair should be neatly tied using a **thin black cotton cloth hair band**.
- **Girls (Long Hair):** Hair must be tied in **two neat braids**, secured with **black rubber bands**, along with a **thin black cotton cloth hair band**.

Other important instructions:

- Students are expected to come to school neat and tidy. The prescribed school uniform is to be worn in school and at **school functions by all students and by those students representing the school anywhere else**.
- Parents are expected to co-operate in the working of the school by enforcing regularity and discipline and by taking an interest in their children's progress. Parents should check the ERP every day and acknowledge notes from the teachers (if any).
- Parents can communicate with the Class Teacher via ERP to schedule meetings during working hours. If requested by the school, parents must attend meetings at the scheduled time.
- Parents are not allowed to meet their wards during school hours without permission from the Principal. Entry into the classrooms and the staff room is also prohibited.
- Parents visiting the school on various occasions/ coming to drop and pick up the children are requested to be appropriately dressed keeping in line with the sanctity and decorum of the school.
- Parents/Guardians must drop and pick up their wards on time. Delays cause inconvenience for everyone, especially during assemblies and school-organized picnics. For parents who are picking up their wards after remediation sessions, the pickup time is 3:35 PM.
- If a child reports late to school more than twice in a month, the parent will be called and the child will be sent home or will not be allowed inside the school premises.
- Parents must update their mobile numbers to receive any communication from the school. In case, the parent is not receiving the messages he/she must notify this to the school immediately.
- This being an English Medium School, the students are to be encouraged to speak in English at all times during school hours, **except when attending the vernacular classes**.

- Students are responsible for the safe custody of their books and personal belongings at school. Parents are requested **not to allow** cash or costly articles to be brought to school by their wards. **Unauthorized cash, mobiles, hidden and forbidden articles found with the student will be confiscated.**
- An Identity Card will be issued to every student. Students must wear it to school every day.
- Students should participate in co-curricular activities such as Scouts & Guides, Drama, Quiz, Games, Art, Music and Singing. (whichever applicable)
- Your child may wear civil clothes to school on his/ her birthday. However, distributing eatables or gifts to classmates in the classroom or in the bus is not permitted.
- Do not give gifts to any teachers on Teacher's Day or on any other day.
- Punctual payment of school fees will be appreciated.
- No early departure/half days are allowed. A child is expected to attend a full day at school.
- During exams, if a child comes to school and leaves early after the exam, the child will be marked absent. If there's a medical concern or the child is unwell, the child must not be sent to school.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

The following disciplinary measures may be adopted by the school in dealing with students behaving in a boisterous manner.

1. Oral warning and counselling
 2. Written warning (A Yellow slip will be issued by the Coordinator)
 3. 3 Yellow slips will result in suspension from school up to 7 days
 4. Withdrawal of transport facility for misbehaviour in the school bus.
(In such cases, parents will be responsible for their ward's commute to school and no fee refund for any component of the school fees will be applicable)
- Every student is expected to maintain a respectful, and cordial rapport with the school personnel including teaching, non-teaching, housekeeping and transport staff.
 - Under no circumstances should students engage in disputes with the staff. If there are any grievances, they should directly contact their Class Teacher.
 - Any misconduct towards peers or teachers in class could lead to a suspension of up to one month or even expulsion without prior notice.
 - Parents have to reimburse 100% of the cost of any intentional/unintentional damage to the school property / infrastructure caused by the student. .
 - Students found in possession of items such as iPods, cameras, mobile phones, expensive watches or any other electronic devices as well as cosmetics, combs, perfumes, deodorants, etc., will have these items confiscated. Additionally, they will face up to one week suspension from school.

TRANSPORT RULES

- The school offers the transport facility purely for comfortable and safe ferrying of the students. This should not be deemed as the primary responsibility of the school.
- The facility is available on fixed routes with designated stops. Any changes required in the same should be requested for, in writing. In case found viable, school management shall take an appropriate decision in its favour.
- Parents are expected to be at the stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled arrival of the bus. **Parents can track the bus with the help of the GPS link/app given to them.**
- The bus shall leave the stop at the designated time. In case a student misses the bus, parents are requested to drop the student to the school.
- Requests for a change of bus stop, in case of change in residential address, must be given in writing to the Principal/Admin team at least one week in advance to facilitate the process.
- We expect the student's behaviour in the bus to be exemplary. In case of repetitive misconduct, in spite of warnings, the school shall withdraw the service in order to protect the interest of other students.
- The school shall not be responsible for the private transport operators ferrying the school children.
- Any case of negligence, inappropriate behaviour of the bus driver or the attendant should be immediately brought to the notice of the transport in charge and the school authorities.
- No parent is allowed to enter the bus and talk to students/ maushis. Strict action could be taken if parents enter the bus and threaten/ shout/ scold the other students in the bus.
- If there is any misconduct reported by the maushis in the bus, the concerned parents will be called and the parents must resolve the matter on their own.
- Damage to seats, disrespect to the helping staff, disobeying the instructions given by the bus maushis could lead to the suspension of transport service for the child.
